Uniform Reminder: July 2019

Jewellery

On health and safety grounds **we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school.**

The exceptions to this rule are **plain earring studs (no jewels as these can get caught on clothing), one earring per lobe; and a watch.** Pupils are not permitted to wear necklaces or bracelets (other than for faith reasons).

We ask that during PE and games, the children either remove or cover ear-rings with a plaster which should be provided from home. With younger children it is advisable for parents to remove earrings on P.E days.

Where children choose to wear stud ear-rings, the school accepts no responsibility for their loss or damage.

Extreme haircuts

The school does not permit children to have haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children. Haircuts that are unconventional, have lined patterns or designs cut into them or are unnatural in colour are unacceptable. Long hair should always be tied back for P.E or Games.

Footwear

The school wants all children to grow into healthy adults. We believe that it is dangerous for children to wear shoes with platform soles or high heels in school, so we do not allow this. **Neither do we allow children to wear trainers to school;** these are appropriate for sport or as leisurewear, but do not offer the required degree of support to pupils' growing feet; may lead to fungal infections when worn throughout the school day; are not in keeping with the smart appearance of a school uniform, and, at times, may lead to feelings of inequality between children. **We require all children to wear the types of shoe described in the uniform list i.e. sensible black school shoes, below the ankle – no open toes.**

In hot weather, children may wear low black or blue school sandals which are designed to support a child's feet effectively. Toe posts should **not** be worn and sandals must have a solid ankle strap.

School Uniform

White Polo shirt

Black or grey trousers/tailored shorts/skirt/pinafore dresses/shalwar kameez

Navy blue sweatshirt or navy blue cardigan with school logo

Plain black, low-heeled shoes, **no boots (above the ankle)**

Blue/white check summer dress

Low black or blue school sandals with a solid ankle strap and **no toe posts.**

Sweatshirts with the school logo can be purchased at Natasha's in Bradford.

Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name.

PE kit

Plain black, grey or navy jogging bottoms or shorts

Plain white t-shirt

Plain black or navy sweatshirt or 'hoodie' for outdoor PE during winter

Black or white trainers (these may have small brand logos) – for outdoor PE

Black indoor pumps

PE Bag: **this will be provided by school**

Year 5 Swimming

Swimming trunks, swimsuit or swimming costume and footless leggings

Swimming cap or hair bobble for long hair.

Towel

Waterproof bag

Please note: NO BANGLES, RINGS, NECKLACES, NOSE STUDS OR WATCHES TO BE WORN IN SCHOOL Hair ornaments are to be black, brown or blue. Hair bands/scrunchies are allowed, but no fashion ornaments please E.G. Jo Jo Bows.

Shoes must be plain – no sparkles etc.
