



In **English** lessons this term, we will continue to read adventure

stories with characters on a journey. We will explore newspaper reports and the children will write their own newspaper report about "The Vanishings" in Variak Paw.





We will then read different myths focusing particularly on Greek myths and legends.

You can help by: Sharing suitable newspaper articles and looking at the features e.g. headings, witness accounts. Asking children about the stories we are reading. Reading with and encouraging children to read every night and discussing the books they read. Remember to record in the reading journal and help children to complete the activities.

For <u>Maths</u> this term, we will be subtracting 2 4-digit numbers. We will then explore multiplication and division and the children will learn the times tables they are not yet familiar with mainly 6, 7, 9, 11,12. They should already be fluent in the 2, 5, 10, 4 and 8 times tables. Times Tables are an essential part of learning in Year 4 so children will frequently be practising their times tables. At the end of the term we will also be exploring working out length and perimeter.

You can help by: Practising times tables and making sure children are improving their rock speeds using Times Table Rockstars online.

<u>Reading</u> - Please make sure that your child is reading every evening at home and that you are signing their reading record. Children who read more also become better writers.

Homework

Spelling and maths facts to learn will be sent out every **Friday**. Children will also have a choice of other homework tasks to complete related to our topic.

This term we will be studying the geography of Mexico

Geography
