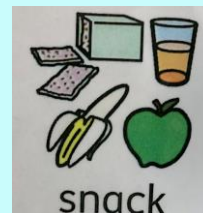


Reading and Writing

We have lots of different technology which can help children who struggle with reading and writing. Here, a child is using Clicker 7 Software and a large-lettered keyboard.

Clicker 7 helps with writing and spelling as it reads the children's work back to them so they can check it.

We use Widgit software to make symbols. In Early Years, this helps children with limited language to communicate and understand school routines. Here are some which are used around nursery.

We run a range of interventions and groups to help children at Holybrook. Teachers feel that these children need a special mention as they have been responding so well to their additional help:

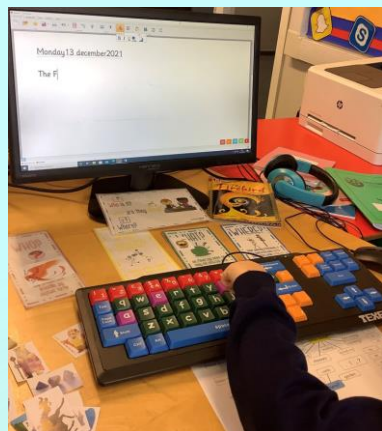
- Horizons - Marcel is beginning to regulate himself; he has become the Horizons' site manager! Harry is now able to regulate himself if someone comes into class and is the Times table Rockstars champion. Archie is working very hard in lessons with his writing.
- Reception – Oliver is now talking about his feelings/emotions. Sienna is talking more to familiar adults and beginning to talk and play with other children. Sarah is beginning to develop her story telling and imagination through role play and she is beginning to use more words alongside Makaton.
- Year 1 - Sadie has achieved all of her speech and language targets. Georgie and Catherine have finished their Wellcomm intervention. Alex has passed level 8 on Wellcomm too.
- Year 2 – Nelly O'Reilly is doing well with her number bonds to 10 in her precision teaching sessions.
- Year 3 – Talia, Ashley, Summer and Jessica are all progressing well in their phonics intervention.
- Year 4 – Kenny has achieved his targets from the speech therapist. Kelsey has now learnt her 3 x tables during Precision Teaching. Darcey now knows her number bonds to 10.
- Year 5 – Vinny, Liam and Angel have all completed a level of their times-tables in their Precision Teaching intervention.
- Year 6 – Lexi is improving the amount of time she works independently.
