Here at Holybrook, we are very lucky to have a school-commissioned Speech Therapist (Seona Bailey, pictured left) who works with pupils with speech, language and communication difficulties in the mainstream school. She visits us for a day a fortnight. We also have Claire Buchanan (pictured right) who helps children in our Horizons Resourced Provision. Our therapists assess children's difficulties and then set them targets to achieve. They also offer training to our staff so we can support children as well as possible. Last week, Claire trained some teaching assistants how to use 'Blank Level Questions' to help children who find comprehension and following instructions difficult.
